<u>TELEGRAPH ROAD – PARCEL ID#'S 009-001-00 & 009-047-00:</u> Michael Bosanac, County Administrator; TC Clements, CEO of Monroe County Business Alliance and Dr. Kojo Quartey, President of Monroe County Community College spoke to the Board that they are in favor of the proposed rezoning.

And further, to request the Planning Commission to address the changes in the development trend in this area as it reviews the Master Plan. The Applicant has also agreed to start construction within 3 years as a rezoning condition and that agreement is a condition of the approval. A roll call vote was taken.
